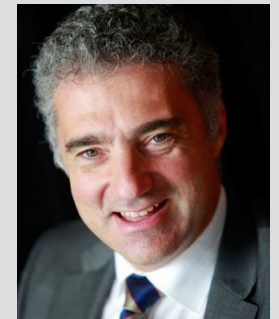
Message from Paul Nicolaou, CEO AHA NSW

Fair Work Commission

Deputy President Peter JA Sams AM was appointed to Fair Work Australia in 2010 after eleven years as a Deputy President of the Industrial Relations Commission of NSW. He was Secretary of the Labor Council of New South Wales between 1994 and 1998, having served as Industrial Officer, Organiser and Assistant Secretary between 1982 and 1994.

He was also President of the NSW Branch of the ALP between 1997 and 1998. His responsibilities at Fair Work Australia include membership of the Major Resources/Infrastructure Project Panel and a number of industry panel assignments. He is a former director of Sydney Water Corporation, Federal Airports Corporation, the Maritime Services Board of NSW, Chifley Financial Services and Labour Union Insurance.



Professor Andrew Stewart
Professor of Law, University of Adelaide

Andrew Stewart is the John Bray Professor of Law at the University of Adelaide, a consultant to the national law firm Piper Alderman and President of the Australian Labour Law Association. One of Australia's leading experts in employment law and workplace relations, he assisted the federal government with the drafting and structure of the Fair Work legislation, and has recently worked with Rosemary Owens on Australia's first major report on unpaid work experience, commissioned by the Fair Work Ombudsman.

Andrew's many publications include Stewart's Guide to Employment Law, now in its fourth edition from Federation Press, and Independent Contractors: A Practical Guide, published this year by CCH.
